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Notes on Installation

INSTALLATION PRECAUTIONS



CAUTION

- The Road Angel Stereo is designed for **12V DC negative ground operation system only**. Before installing the unit, make sure your vehicle is connected to a DC12V negative ground electrical system.
- **The negative battery terminal must be disconnected before making connections**, which can avoid the chance of damaging the Road Angel Stereo due to a short circuit
- Be sure to **connect the colour coded leads correctly** according to the diagram on the Road Angel Stereo itself. Incorrect connection may cause the unit to malfunction or damage the vehicle's electrical system.
- Be sure to connect the speaker (-) leads to the speaker (-) terminals (or vice versa). **Do not cross-wire the left and right speaker channels** or to the vehicle's body.
- **Do not block vents or radiator panels**. Doing so may result in heat build-up inside the unit and may result in a fire.
- **For Android Auto to work, you need to ground the pink cable labelled "PARK"**. Otherwise, Android Auto will not load. This is a built in safety feature common on all aftermarket headunits with Android Auto.

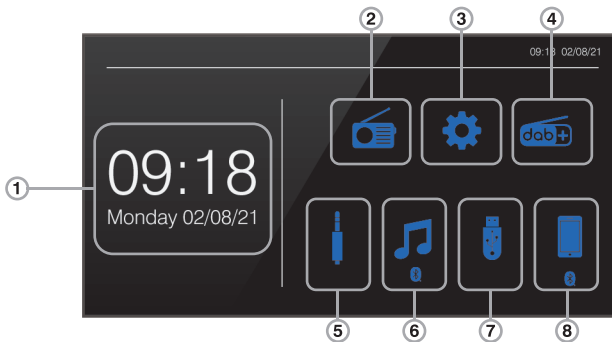
MAIN PANEL AND INSTRUMENTATION










①	🏠	Touch to return to the home screen.
②	🔌	Touch to mute. To unmute, touch again. Touch and hold to power off. To power back on, touch again.
③	+ -	Touch (+) for volume increase and (-) for volume decrease.
④	🎤	Touch to activate the voice control. When an iPhone or Android device is connected, you can active Google Assistant or Siri
⑤	RST	Press to reset the stereo

ADJUSTING DATE/TIME AND SOUND



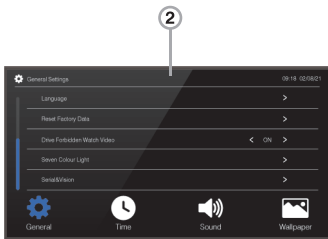
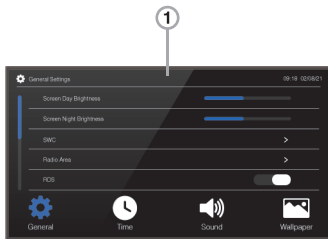
1		Once in the Date & Time settings, simply scroll up and down in the individual segments to find the appropriate setting. Touch the home screen icon  on the left of the screen to save.
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2		Once in the Sound Settings you can adjust the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The volume of the beeping when the screen is touched.• Reversing volume when an external camera is fitted.• Speaker balance settings.• Subwoofer Settings.• Volume Control.
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3		Once in the Balance Setting you can drag around the cross-hairs centre  to get the required balance or manually adjust using the Fade & Balance.
		Touch to adjust the preferred acoustic and Graphic Equaliser settings.
		Reset Sound Settings.

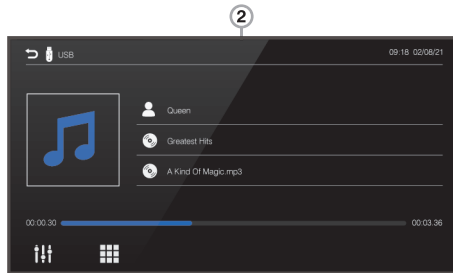
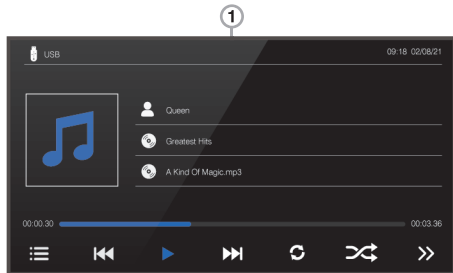

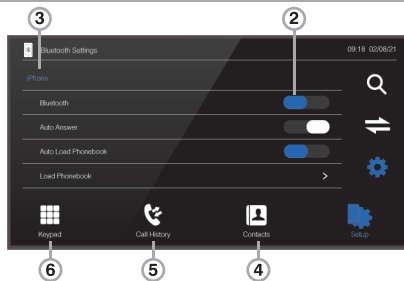
SETTING AND SAVING RADIO STATIONS








①		Turn on/off TA (Traffic Announcements) & search DX (Distant Signals) & (Alternative frequencies).
②	⏪⏩	Search for Radio Stations.
③	📶	Touch to switch Radio bands between FM1, FM2, FM3, AM1 & AM2 or touch the bands themselves.
④	🎚️	Touch to adjust the preferred Acoustic and Graphic Equaliser settings.
⑤	🔍	Touch to scan through saved stations. Hold to scan for a good signal.
⑥	📡	Touch to toggle between DX (Distant Reception) & LOC (Line Output Converter).
⑦	📱	Touch to open the frequency keyboard. Manually input a Radio Station or choose a pre-stored selection.
⑧		Go To Keyboard.

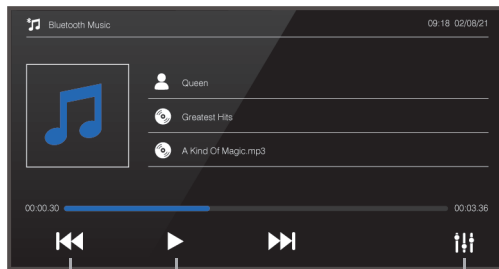
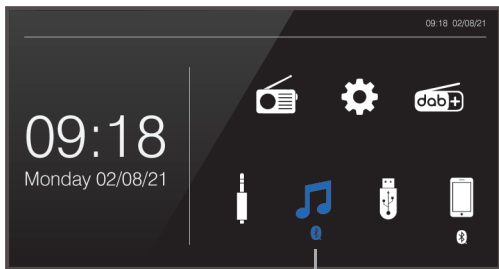
PHONE BLUETOOTH SETTINGS & PAIRING








①		To pair a new device follow these steps: Open Bluetooth phone's on the stereo & ensure your phones Bluetooth is on.
②		Switch on the Road Angel Stereo's Bluetooth. Once your device's detects the Road Angel Stereo, select pairing to the Stereo. You will be prompted to allow the Stereo access to your Contacts.
③		Once connection is successful, you will see your device's name appear here.
④		All your device's contacts will be available here when the Auto Load Phonebook toggle is set to on.
⑤		Touch to access your device's Call History.
⑥		Touch to reveal the keypad where you can manually input a telephone number.
		Do not attempt to connect your device whilst the vehicle is in motion.

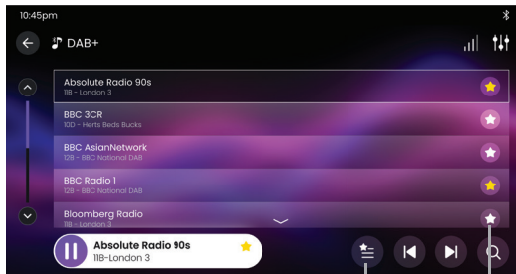
BLUETOOTH MUSIC

		Do not attempt to connect your device whilst the vehicle is in motion.

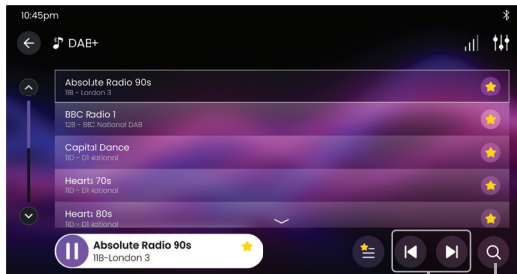

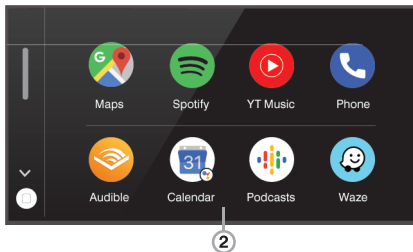

INTRODUCTION

It is not practical for us to print a full installation guide for every vehicle as there are thousands of variations. We advise this installation is carried out by an experienced car audio installer.

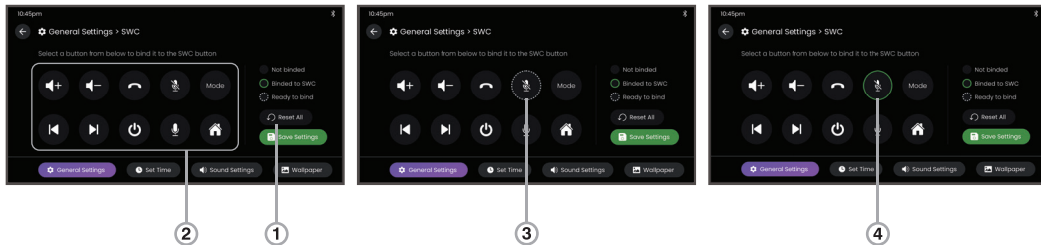
You may need a fitting kit for your vehicle, below is an example of such which fits a VW Transporter T6 2015 2019. The reason you may need a fitting kit is due to the vehicle specific connects not being ISO connections so they may need adapting. Please consult your local car audio specialist or retailer to obtain such parts



The Road Angel RA-X stereos are standard 2-DIN size and have ISO connections. This means the stereo will fit any aftermarket parts using ISO components.

STEERING WHEEL CONTROLS



①	↻	Press "Reset All"
②		Press the function you want to program
③	⋯	When the function has a dotted border, press the button on the steering wheel you would like to program.
④	○	The function should display a green border to indicate a successful pairing.
		Quick Tip: Some vehicle command signals to the stereo are weaker than others. If you have trouble mapping controls. Please change the "SWC Resistance" to "High". This is located in the previous menu.

REVERSING CAMERA

“The Road Angel stereo accepts all reversing cameras with a standard yellow video connector.”



How to connect reverse camera:

①	Connect your reversing camera video feed into “CAM” which is located at the rear of the unit
②	Connect your reversing camera 12V power feed to the +12V Camera cable on the rear of the stereo
③	Connect your reversing camera trigger to the Orange cable on the rear of the stereo

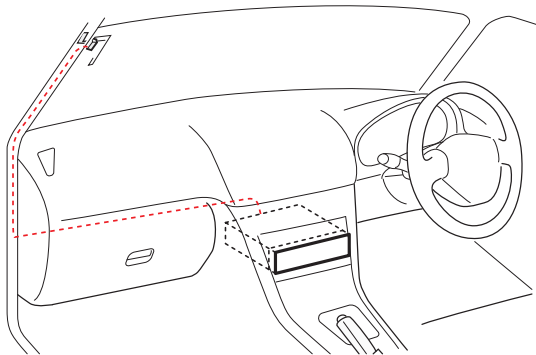

DAB ANTENNA INSTALLATION

Fitting Instructions ¹

Mounting and wiring the Road Angel Amplified DAB Antenna requires a degree of skill and experience and we advise it being installed by a professional. If you have problems during the installation, please consult your Road Angel dealer by calling **0330 320 3030**.

The antenna should be installed on the passenger side for safety. The direction of the Windscreen Antenna will change depending on whether the Windscreen Antenna is installed on the right side or left side of the vehicle.



Disconnect the battery's negative terminal before installing the unit.

DAB ANTENNA INSTALLATION

Fitting Instructions ²

Be sure to check the installation location of Vehicle Windscreen Antenna before installing as this cannot be reapplied to the windscreen once removed.

Do not install at the following locations:

- Where it may block driver's view.
- Where it may obstruct operation of safety devices such as air bags.
- On movable glass surfaces.

Signal strength will decrease at the following locations:

- On IR reflecting glass/mirrored glass film and thermal insulated glass.
- Where it overlaps another radio antenna.
- Where it overlaps window heating wires.
- At side/rear of vehicle (door, quarter, rear window).

Reception may decrease due to noise when the wipers, air con, or engine is turned on. It may also decrease depending on the direction of the broadcast station and that of the vehicle (antenna) direction.

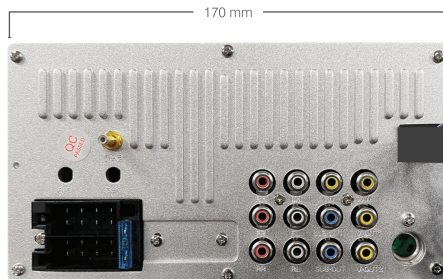
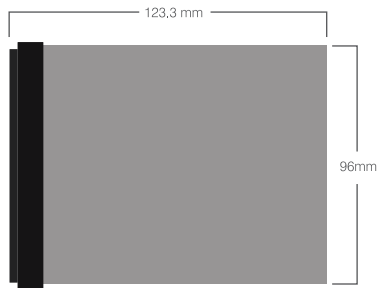
It may not be possible to install on some type of vehicles.

Do not bend or damage the Vehicle Internal Windscreen Antenna.

Issue/Question	Solution
Unit keeps losing memory	Some vehicles have the permanent and switch live the wrong way. Swap the red & Yellow cable over in the ISO loom at the bullet connection.
Cannot get all steering wheel control functions	Not all functions can be retained when changing to aftermarket stereos. Please change "SWC resistance" to "high" to get the best possible function from the stereo.
Can I add Rear monitors to stereo?	Yes, use the "video out" connector on stereo.
Can I add Rear Camera?	Yes, this unit works with all major branded cameras.
Can I fit it myself?	DIY installation is not recommended. We advise you have this product installed by an experienced technician.

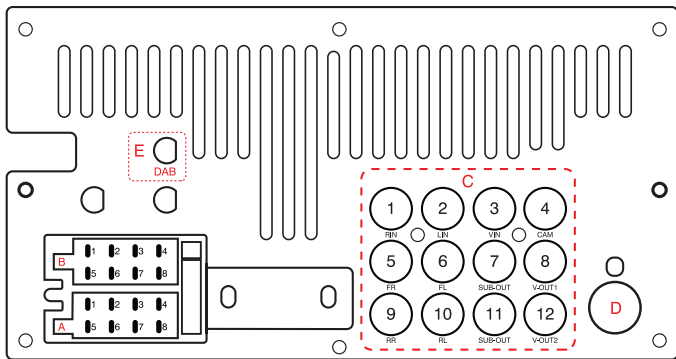
